Referral Criteria

Suitability for prosthodontic treatment will be determined after an initial consultation with Dr Mukar. This will consist of a full clinical examination and radiographs to assess the extent of the patient's concerns. All the options and choices available to the patient will be discussed in detail. A full report will be sent to you, the referring dentist, and the patient will have a written estimate of the fees involved.

During treatment at Woodford Dental Care, the patient is always reminded of the importance of continuing to visit you for regular examinations and treatment. Referred patients will not be accepted for any treatment other than that which the referring dentist has requested.
